

## **RECIPE**

### **Sugar Cookies**

Makes about 5 dozen cookies

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 ½ cups powdered sugar 1 cup butter (softened)
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- ½ teaspoon almond extract
- 2 ½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon cream of tartar Granulated sugar

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Mix powdered sugar, butter, egg, vanilla, and almond extract. Mix in flour, baking soda and cream of tartar.

Cover and refrigerate at least 2 hours. Heat oven **350 degrees**. Divide dough into halves. Roll each half out to desired thickness on lightly floured surface. Cut into shapes.

Sprinkle with granulated sugar and place on lightly greased sheet. Bake until edges are light brown, 7-9 minutes. Makes about 5 dozen cookies.

**Note:** I have left the almond extract out of these cookies before and they are still tasty. I divide the dough into 2 halves and wrap in plastic wrap then refrigerate overnight. You can skip the granulated sugar if you decide to decorate with frosting.






