



RECIPE

California Pasta Salad

From HCE/Triangle Cooking for a Cure Cookbook

INGREDIENTS

1lb. think spaghetti, broken into 1-inch pieces

3 large tomatoes, diced

2 medium zucchini, diced

1 large cucumber, diced

1 medium green pepper, diced

1 large red onion, diced

2 cans (2 ¼ oz each) sliced ripe olives, drained

1 bottle (16 oz) Italian salad dressing

1/4 cup grated Parmesan or Romano cheese

1 Tbsp sesame seeds

2 tsp. poppy seeds

1 tsp paprika

½ tsp. celery seed

1/4 tsp. garlic powder

DIRECTIONS

Cook spaghetti according to package directions; drain and rinse in cold water. Place in a large bowl; add remaining ingredients. Toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate overnight.

RECIPE

White Texas Sheet Cake

From HCE/Triangle Cooking for a Cure Cookbook

INGREDIENTS

1 cup butter or margarine

1 cup water

2 cups all-purpose flour

2 cups sugar

2 eggs, beaten

½ cup sour cream

1 tsp. almond extract

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. baking soda

Frosting:

½ cup butter or margarine ¼ cup milk

4 ½ cups confectioners' sugar ½ tsp. almond extract

1 cup chopped walnuts

DIRECTIONS

In a large saucepan, bring butter and water to a boil. Remove from the heat; stir in flour, sugar, eggs, sour cream, extract, salt and baking soda until smooth. Pour into a greased 15-in.x 10-in. x 1-in. baking pan. Bake at 375° for 20-22 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 20 minutes. Meanwhile, for frosting, combine butter and milk in a saucepan. Bring to a boil. Remove from the heat; add sugar and extract. Mix well. Stir in walnuts; spread over warm cake.

RECIPE

Spicey Pork Tenderloin

INGREDIENTS

1 to 3 Tbsp chili powder

1 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. ground ginger

1/4 tsp. ground thyme

¼ tsp. pepper

2 pork tenderloins (about 1 pound each)

DIRECTIONS

Combine the first five ingredients; rub over tenderloins. Cover and refrigerate for 2-4 hours. Grill uncovered over medium-hot heat for 15 minutes per side or until a meat thermometer reads 160° .

Due to boulders and weather, we were unable to complete our Big Timber town and the Whispering Pines projects and have had to move them into the 2023 construction season. The scheduled 2023 Fiber to the Home projects in 2023 will be South Chester, Geraldine and additional projects around Big Timber. The Hays and Lodgepole fiber upgrades are on hold until the Ft Belknap Indian Community Council gives Triangle the needed Right of Way to complete the entire existing service area of Hays and Lodgepole.

AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM (ACP)

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

THE ACP BENEFIT PROVIDES:

- Up to \$30/month discount for internet service.
- Up to \$75/month for households on qualifying Tribal lands.

A HOUSEHOLD IS ELIGIBLE IF A MEMBER MEETS AT LEAST ONE OF THE CRITERIA **BELOW:**

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Participates in certain assistance programs such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC or Lifeline.
- Participates in Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations.
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including

through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision in the 2019-2020, 2020-2021, or 2021-2022 school year.

Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.

THREE-STEPS TO ENROLL:

- 1. To apply, go to AffordableConnectivity.gov or print out a mail-in application.
- 2. Once your application is approved, contact Triangle at 1-800-332-1201 with your Qualifying ID Number.
- 3. Complete the forms the customer service representative emails you to select Triangle as your provider.

If you are having issues with Triangle Communications regarding an ACP-supported service or having difficulties enrolling with Triangle Communications, please contact our office or stop by for assistance. Additional discounts may be available through the Federal Lifeline program. Members may qualify for and receive assistance from both federal programs.

SCAM OF THE WEEK:

REAL FACEBOOK PAGE, FAKE FACEBOOK **SUPPORT**

Facebook pages are typically used by organizations and public figures to connect with their community. Anyone can make a Facebook page. even cybercriminals. Using social media, cybercriminals spoof brands and organizations to trick people into trusting them. In this recent scam, cybercriminals use real Facebook pages to impersonate Facebook itself.

The scam starts with a fake email that looks like it's from Facebook. The email states that your account has been deactivated and will be deleted in 48 hours unless you click a link. If you click the link, you're taken to a real Facebook post from a page named "Page Support" that uses the Facebook logo. The post directs you to click another suspicious link that takes you to a fake login page. If you enter your login credentials, you'll

give cybercriminals access to your Facebook profile and the ability to scam your friends and family.

Don't be fooled! Follow the tips below to stay safe from similar scams:

- Watch out for a sense of urgency in emails. Phishing attacks rely on impulsive actions, so always think before you click.
- Remember that this type of attack isn't exclusive to Facebook. Cybercriminals could use this technique on any other social media platform.
- If you receive an urgent notification, verify that it's legitimate. Navigate directly to the organization's website or official app to view details.



PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SPOOFING CALLS

Have you ever answered a phone call • or text because you know the name on the caller ID only to find out that is not the person on the other end? The caller starts asking you for personal information and to identify that your number is an active line. They might start pressuring you for information. This is called spoofing. According to the FCC, "Spoofing is when a caller deliberately falsifies the information transmitted to your caller ID display to disquise their identity."

Scammers take advantage of victims by playing on their fears. Hang up if you suspect a call is a scam. Scammers also spoof mobile numbers using them to text scams. The FCC has recently received reports of COVID-19 text scams. Be wary of texts advertising a COVID-19 cure, free testing for COVID-19 and pharmacy scams.

Here are a few tips to avoid being spoofed:

- Scammers can spoof phone numbers, emails, and texts.
- Be suspicious. Scammers will try to pressure you, use intimidation, or make the offer sound too good to be true.

- Do not respond to calls or texts from unknown numbers or emails if they seem suspicious.
- Do not click on links in text messages.
- Be suspicious of offers asking for insurance or doctor information.
- Do not let anyone pressure you to share information or to make a payment immediately.
- If the caller says they represent a company or government agency. Hang up and call the number on your account statement or check their website.
- Scammers target seniors so make sure you warn parents and grandparents.

If you have been a victim of a spoofing scam, report it to the FCC on their website, www.fcc.gov.

Each day Triangle receives large number of payments. Once the payments are opened and sorted by company, the bill statements accompanied by checks are run through a machine which reads the statement and the check. This process allows us to post payments to our members' accounts quickly.

Here a few other tips to making sure your payment can be processed quickly:

Enclose the payment stub with your payment.

- Please **DO NOT** staple, tape or paper clip your payment to the payment stub. Staples and tape can cause problems with the machine and those payments must be processed separately.
- If there are special instructions for your payment(s), please make note on the payment stub or write a note on a piece of paper but DO NOT attach to the stub.
- Please use blue or black pen. Other colors can not be read by our payment processor.

- Phone, Internet and mobile phone payments can be paid with one check, but please send the payment stubs or write all the account numbers on the memo line on your check.
